

ISLAMIC REMINDER

Do Not Cause Regret in Your Gatherings

USTADZ SHADY MOHAB

Assalam Alaikum wa Rahmatullah wa Barakatuh Dear Parents and Students,

In our lives, whether we gather for socializing, business, or other objectives, it's essential to remember that as Muslims, our practices and behaviors set us apart. We should strive to be good examples in all aspects of our lives, even during our normal activities. This includes incorporating the remembrance of Allah and sending blessings upon the Prophet Muhammad into our gatherings.

The Prophet Muhammad ﷺ said:

"No people gather in a sitting in which they do not remember Allah, nor send Salat upon their Prophet, except it will be a cause of regret for them. If He wills, He will punish them, and if He wills, He will forgive them."

At-Tirmidhi: Authentic]



This means that if we gather without remembering Allah or sending blessings on the Prophet ﷺ, we may miss out on valuable rewards and could feel regret later.

To avoid this, we should make a habit of including the remembrance of Allah and sending blessings on the Prophet in our gatherings. Additionally, the Prophet taught us a special supplication to say at the end of our meetings to seek forgiveness for any mistakes or idle talk that might have occurred:

"Subhanaka Allahumma wa bihamdika, ash-hadu alla ilaha illa Anta, astaghfiruka wa atubu ilayk" (Glory is to You, O Allah, and praise is to You. I bear witness that there is no deity except You;
I seek Your forgiveness and repent to You).

[At-Tirmidhi: Authentic]

By saying this, we ask Allah to forgive any sins that might have happened during the gathering, making it a form of remembrance of Allah and a way to cleanse our hearts. These teachings remind us that our gatherings should be filled with the remembrance of Allah and should end with seeking His forgiveness. This simple practice ensures that our time together is blessed and that we avoid the regret mentioned in the hadith.

As Muslims, we must ensure that our gatherings reflect our commitment to Islamic values and serve as a reminder of our faith. Even in our everyday interactions and meetings, integrating the remembrance of Allah and sending blessings upon the Prophet senhances the spiritual quality of our interactions and upholds our identity as Muslims.

STUDENTS HANDPHONE AND PERSONAL DEVICES


Kindergarten and primary students are **prohibited** from bringing personal phones or devices (e.g., AirPods, iPads).



the PTA nomination held on 23 August was met with enthusiasm. We value the active participation of our parents in shaping our school community and appreciate their involvement.




MERDEKA DAY CELEBRATION - 30TH AUGUST

STUDENT COUNCIL AND COMMITTEE NOMINATION


