Doctors Don't Cure, Allah Does



بسم الله والصلاة والسلام على رسول الله

In Islam, it is essential to understand that Allah is the ultimate healer. Doctors, medicines, and even Ruqyah are all means that Allah has allowed them to exist, but they themselves do not have inherent power to cure. They are simply tools or channels through which Allah's will is carried out.

The Prophet Ibrahim عليه السلام when he was debating with his people, he reminded them of Allah's supreme power, and he stated: "وإذا مَرضْتُ فهو يَشْفَيْن

"And when I am ill, it is He who heals me." (Surat Ash-Shu'ara:80)



Imagine two individuals suffering from the same disease. Both go to the same doctor, receive the same treatment, and take the same medicine. If one of them is healed, does it mean that the other will definitely be cured? The answer is no, because Allah's will is the ultimate deciding factor, not the doctor, the medicine, or the treatment itself. This simply means that Allah has allowed them to exist and be effective with the first one only, as the outcome is determined by His will alone.

This concept reinforces the idea that, just like Prophet Ibrahim عليه السلام acknowledged Allah as the source of healing, we too must understand that the means we use—whether doctors, medicines, or Ruqyah—are not cures by themselves. They are tools created by Allah for us to use, but Allah alone has the power to heal.

This is why When the Prophet (ﷺ) visited any ailing member of his family, he would touch the sick person with his right hand and would supplicate:

"اللهم رب الناس، أذهب البأس، واشف، أنت الشافي لا شفاء إلا شفاؤك، شفاءً لا يغادر سقماً"

"Allahumma Rabban–nasi, adhhibil–ba'sa, washfi, Antash–Shafi, la shifa'a illa shifa'uka, shifaan la yughadiru saqaman

[O Allah! the Rabb of mankind! Remove this disease and cure (him or her)! You are the Curer. There is no cure but through You, which leaves behind no disease]."
[Al-Bukhari and Muslim].

Muslims must take the means that Allah allowed them to exist and be effective, but our hearts must place our trust in Allah as the true source of healing, because the outcome is determined by His will alone.







HYGIENE AWARENESS CAMPAIGN


The Student Council led a campaign promoting health and hygiene practices among students through engaging activities and informational resources.
