ISLAMIC REMINDER

Folding the Earth and Displaying it to the Prophet ﷺ

USTADZ SHADY MOHAB



بِسْمِ اللَّهِ وَالصَّلَاةِ وَالسَّلَامِ عَلَى رَسُولِ اللَّهِ

Thauban رضي الله عنه reported that prophet ﷺ said:

"إِنَّ اللَّهَ رَوَى لِي الْأَرْضَ، فَزَايَتْ مَشَارِقَهَا وَمَغَارِبَهَا، وَإِنِّي أُمْتِي سَيَنْلِقُ مَلْكُهَا مَا رَوَى لِي مِنهَا، وَأَعْطَيْتُ الْكَفْرَيْنِ الْأَخْمَرَ وَالْأَبْيَضَ، وَإِنِّي سَأَلْتُ رَبِّي لِيُؤْتِيَنِي أَنْ لَا يُهْلِكَنِي بَسَنَةٌ عَامَّةٌ، وَأَنْ لَا يَسْلُطَ عَلَيْهِمْ عَدُوٌّ مِنْ سِوَى أَنفُسِهِمْ، فَيَسْتَبِيحُ بِيَضَّتِهِمْ، وَإِنِّي رَأَيْتُ قَالًا: يَا مُحَمَّدُ، إِنِّي إِذَا قَضَيْتُ قَضَاءَ فَإِنَّهُ لَا يُرَدُّ، وَإِنِّي أَعْطَيْتُكَ لِأُمَّتِكَ أَنْ لَا أَهْلِكَنِي بَسَنَةٌ عَامَّةٌ، وَأَنْ لَا أَسْلُطَ عَلَيْهِمْ عَدُوٌّ مِنْ سِوَى أَنفُسِهِمْ، يَسْتَبِيحُ بِيَضَّتِهِمْ، وَلَوْ اجْتَمَعَ عَلَيْهِمْ مَنْ بِالْقَطْرِهَا -أَوْ قَالَ: مَنْ بَيْنَ الْقَطْرِهَا- حَتَّى يَكُونَ بَعْضُهُمْ لِبَلَدِكَ بَعْضًا، وَيَسْبِي بَعْضُهُمْ بَعْضًا!"

[Sahih Muslim]

In this hadith, the Prophet ﷺ informs of some of the blessings Allah bestowed upon him and his ummah, and of the vast spread of Islam across the earth. He said, "Indeed, Allah gathered the earth for me," meaning He folded it and displayed it all at once before him, so the Prophet ﷺ saw its eastern and western extents and all its regions.

saw the territories his ummah would eventually possess in the farthest east and west. Thus, the Prophet ﷺ continued, "And the dominion of my ummah will reach whatever was gathered for me from the west. He the earth," meaning that the land his ummah will rule will extend as far as he was shown. "I was also given the two treasures, the red and the white," referring to the treasures of gold and silver, meaning the wealth of the Persian and Roman empires, the rulers of Iraq and the Levant

Then, the Prophet ﷺ said, "I asked my Lord and prayed to Him for my ummah, that He would not destroy it through a widespread famine," meaning that a general famine would not afflict the entire ummah at once; if a famine occurs, it will only affect a limited area in comparison to the rest of the Muslim lands. "And that He would not allow a foreign enemy from among the disbelievers to overpower them, thus destroying their strength," meaning that such an enemy would not wipe out the Muslim community.

The Prophet ﷺ then relates what Allah said to him: "O Muhammad, when I decree a matter, it cannot be overturned." That is, when He issues a firm decree, it cannot be altered or prevented but will come to pass. "I have granted you for your ummah that they will not be destroyed through a general famine of drought, hunger, or hardship, and that I will not allow a foreign enemy to overpower them, destroying their strength, even if all others conspired against them." This means that no enemy from the disbelievers will completely overwhelm them, even if all opponents of the Muslims unite against them. However, some Muslims might turn against one another, capturing and fighting each other. When this happens, the unity of the Muslims will break, and they will be preoccupied with internal conflicts instead of striving against the external enemy. This will empower the adversaries and enable them to gain dominance over the Muslims.

SCIENCE FIESTA WITH AN ENTREPRENEURIAL SPIRIT

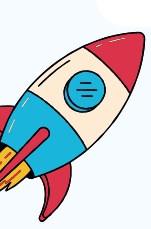

COMMERCE EXHIBITION - 18TH NOVEMBER

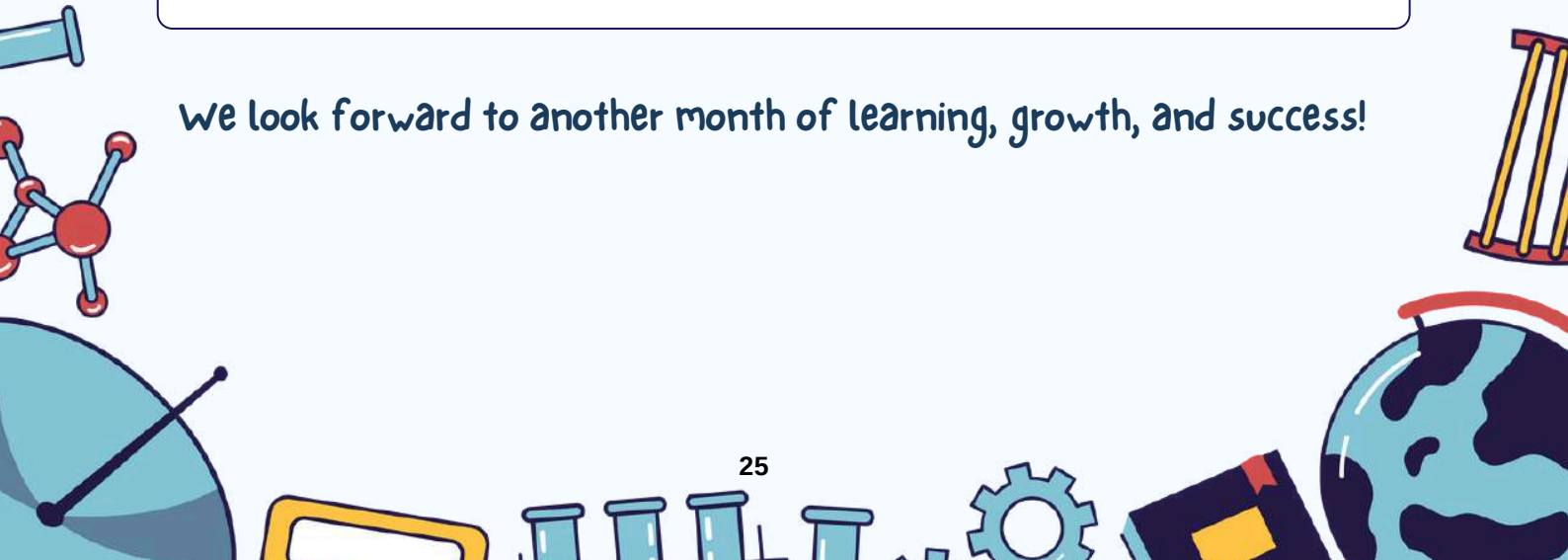

Celebrating diversity, this day will bring together students to showcase the rich cultural heritage within our school. Activities and presentations will foster cultural understanding and inclusivity.

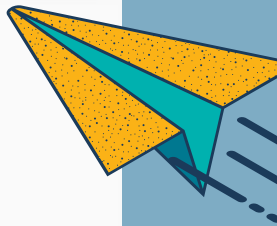
