How to Welcome Ramadan

For our righteous predecessors, Ramadan held a special place in their hearts. They eagerly prepared for it, prayed to witness it, and valued its immense blessings.

Here are some important points to consider when welcoming Ramadan:

1. Sincerity

A firm intention to fill Ramadan with worship, increase good deeds, and avoid sins is essential. The Prophet ﷺ said:

"Actions are judged by intentions, and each person will be rewarded according to their intention." (Bukhari & Muslim)

2. Sincere Repentance

Repenting before Ramadan allows the heart to be purified and prepared for worship. Sins weigh down the soul and create barriers between a person and Allah. A clean heart finds joy in worship and benefits from the blessings of this month.

3. Understanding the Value of Time

Allah describes Ramadan as "a limited number of days," reminding us that it passes quickly. Ibn al-Jawzi said, "A person should recognize the honor and value of time and should not waste a single moment except in acts of worship." The hardship of fasting is temporary, but the reward is eternal.

4. Reducing Food

One of the goals of fasting is self-discipline. Overeating hardens the heart and makes worship burdensome. A lighter stomach allows for greater spiritual focus and energy for prayer.

5. Learning the Fiqh of Fasting

Understanding the rulings of fasting ensures that our worship is correct and accepted. Many fast without proper knowledge, which may result in an invalid or deficient fast.
